The Forest County and Oneida County Sheriff's Office report today that their agencies have made arrests related to burglaries that have occurred in the past several months.

The original investigation stemmed from numerous commercial tavern and resort burglaries in and around the Oneida County area. On December 28, 2009 a Forest County Deputy on routine patrol made contact with a suspicious individual. This contact lead to arrests in Forest County for burglary. As a result of that arrest and subsequent investigation, the following persons were arrested and referred to the Oneida County District Attorney for numerous burglaries that occurred in Oneida County. These same individuals are suspected of being involved in burglaries throughout North Central Wisconsin. Those arrested include:

Benjamin Marquardt, age 30, of Rhinelander

Joshua C. Schoeneck, age 27, of Rhinelander

Andy Krombholz, age 24, of Rhinelander

Dustin Miller, age 23, of Rhinelander

Investigators from Oneida and Forest Counties along with the Rhinelander Police Department are continuing to work with other law enforcement agencies and the crime victims to recover stolen property and resolve the reported burglaries.

Sheriff Hoffman stated "the Deputy from Forest County - who was on routine patrol, is to be commended for his commitment to his duties that resulted in these arrests. I also want to say thanks to the citizens who provided us with information and compliment all of the area law

enforcement officers and agencies for their outstanding cooperative law enforcement effort that resulted in these arrests”
