Town of Pelican – On Thursday, January 12, 2017, Oneida County Sheriff's Dispatch received a complaint from a citizen that their vehicle was stolen from an address in the Town of Pelican. The vehicle was located on Saturday, January 14, 2017 in the city of Rhinelander. Alexander Durand was arrested for Driving a Vehicle without Owner's Consent, Theft of Moveable Property, and Bail Jumping.

During the investigation into the stolen vehicle, it was found that Durand has been stealing U.S. Mail from all over Oneida County as well as other jurisdictions. A large amount of mail has been recovered from Durand's property. Over the next few weeks, the Sheriff's Office will be in contact with those whose mail has been located. The Oneida County Sheriff's Office is contacting other jurisdictions that may be involved. The investigation is ongoing.
