The Oneida County Sheriff's Office is sponsoring two Wisconsin DNR certified hunter education courses. The date, times and location for the courses are as follows:

Class one. September 5th, September 6th, September 7th, September 18th, September 20th and September 21st. Range day will September 23rd. Class times will be from 4 to 7 PM each day.

Class two. October 16th, October 17th, October 19th, October 23rd, October 24th, October 26th. Range day will be October 28th. Class times will be 4 to 7 PM each day.

Cost for each course is \$10 per person.

Students are now required to obtain a DNR customer ID number for any recreational safety class they attend. Please contact the DNR at 1-888-936-7463 to obtain this number before the course begins.
