For Immediate Release – September 13, 2017-UPDATE

Town of Pelican- On Tuesday, September 12, 2017, at approximately 3:17 p.m., the Oneida County Sheriff's 911 Center received a 911 call from a subject reporting that a male shot a firearm into a truck that was parked at their residence. The male suspect then left the scene on a four-wheeler.

Stephen G. Grundman, was identified as the suspect in the incident and he was arrested. Grundman has been booked into the jail for endangering safety by the use of a dangerous weapon, criminal damage, possession of THC with intent to deliver, possession of THC second offense and possession of drug paraphernalia. He will appear in court on Thursday, September 14, 2017 at 1:15 p.m.
