For Immediate Release – September 15, 2017

Town of Cassian- On Friday, September 15, 2017, at approximately 11:10 AM., the Oneida County Sheriff's 911 Center received a 911 call from a subject reporting a two motorcycle crash on Highway 51 near Little Bearskin Road.

The initial investigation indicates that both motorcycles were traveling northbound and were slowing to turn into a driveway when they collided. Both operators were transported to Howard Young Medical Center and one was flown from there.

Oneida County Deputies were assisted by the Cassian Fire Department, Nokomis First Responders, Tomahawk Emergency Medical Services, Rhinelander Emergency Medical Services, and Oneida County Emergency Medical Services. This investigation is ongoing.

Though wearing a helmet is optional for those over 18 years of age operating with a motorcycle permit in Wisconsin, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation strongly recommends the use of a helmet by all motorcycle and moped riders.
