Town of Minocqua - The Oneida County Sheriff's Office in cooperation with the Minocqua Police Department and Woodruff Police Department have arrested two individuals involved in the sale of cocaine in the Town of Minocqua.

On Thursday, December 1, 2011, two individual's were arrested and booked into the Oneida County Jail on charges of delivery of cocaine and conspiracy to distribute cocaine. The suspects are indentified as Dane A. Wisnosky, age 47, owner of the Black Bear Bar, in the Town of Minocqua and Carole J. Schultz , age 42, also of Minocqua. Criminal charges have been filed with the Oneida County District Attorney's Office.

This undercover drug investigation is part of an ongoing and continuing investigation by the Northcentral Drug Enforcement Group.
